Properties:

Universal cleaner for gentle cleaning of oiled, waxed and lacquered wooden and cork floors, whitewashed wooden surfaces, linoleum, vinyl and laminate floors, stone floors, furniture surfaces, tiles, tiles, window frames, doors and plastic surfaces.

It is particularly skin-friendly and biodegradable. Without chemical preservatives, free of chlorine, sal ammoniac and phosphate. Tested for compatibility on 28 different surfaces by the Fresenius Institute.

Ingredients:

Water, anionic and amphoteric surfactant from coconut fat < 5 %, citral, silver sulphate, chlorophyll.



Application:

Generally wipe surfaces only damp (not wet). If necessary, carry out dry cleaning first. Spray household cleaner onto the surface and spread evenly with a moistened BIOFA Floor Mop Art. No. 009975 or a soft, clean cloth and wipe up. In case of heavy soiling, repeat the cleaning process or spray the soiled areas again separately and allow to soak in for a few minutes before wiping up. Tile and other very smooth surfaces may need to be wiped dry after wet cleaning to avoid streaking.

Storage:

Keep cool, protect against frost, and store properly sealed.
